Twenty-one scholarship recipients, selected by a committee of school staff, will be chosen based on *academic achievement, service to Drake and the Marin community, and financial need.*

Please answer the questions below on a separate word-processed page. You must also include a copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) or a copy of the **first two pages** of your parents' 2018 Income Tax Form. **If your parents are divorced/not living together, financial information is required from both parents.** All financial information is confidential and will be shredded or returned to you upon request. If you are unable to submit one of the financial forms, please see Lisa Neumaier immediately.

Since financial need is only one criterion for this scholarship, seniors from all financial backgrounds will be considered and are encouraged to apply.

Please submit your application and financial papers in a 9 x 12 sealed envelope to the College and Career Center by **Friday, April 3, 2020. There will be no exceptions to this deadline.**

1. List the school activities which you have participated in and provide a brief description and how long you have been involved with each activity. Also include your extra-curricular activities, hobbies, community service, internships, work, etc.
2. List honors and awards you have received. (Athletic awards, Honor Crew, CSF, etc.) If your resume has your activities and awards listed, you can submit it to fulfill items #1 & #2.
3. Please share any circumstances which you feel have affected your personal or educational experiences. For example, were your grades impacted by a medical or personal issue? Or have your activities been limited because you have responsibilities at home that have prevented you from joining teams, clubs, etc.? If there is anything else you would want the scholarship committee to know, please include it here. For many of you, there is nothing that needs further explaining.

Students planning to attend a community college or four-year college/university are eligible to apply, as are seniors planning to take a gap year. Students planning to attend a Service Academy, however, should not apply since they will have their full tuition and expenses covered. See Lisa Neumaier if you have any questions or concerns.

The recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards Night on May 28, 2020. As a student applying for this scholarship, you are expected to attend the Awards Celebration if you receive an invitation to it.
